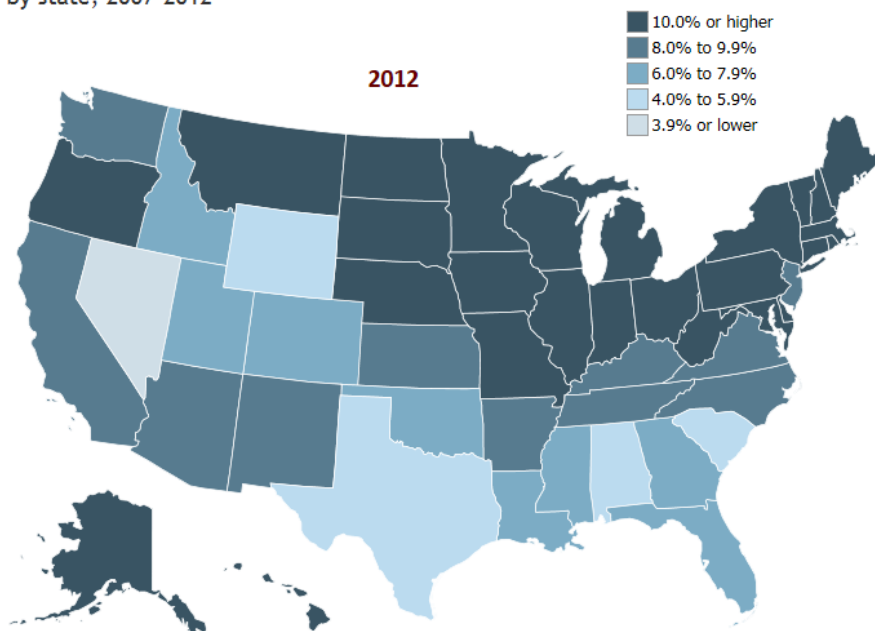

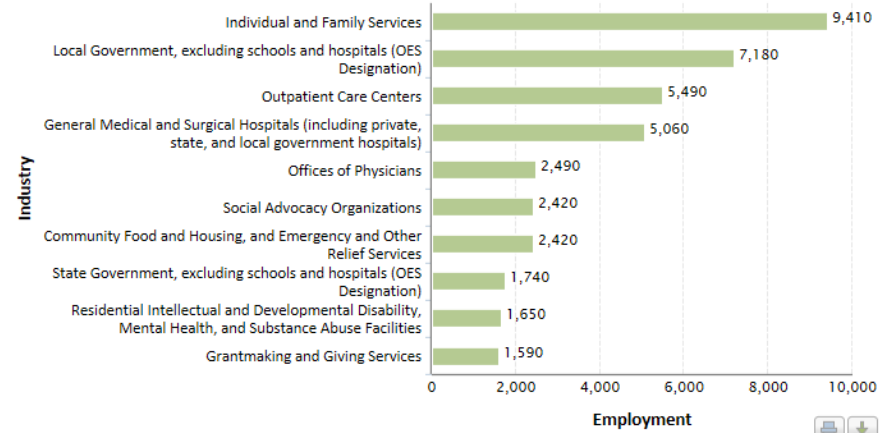

Industries with the highest employment level for Fundraisers, May 2016



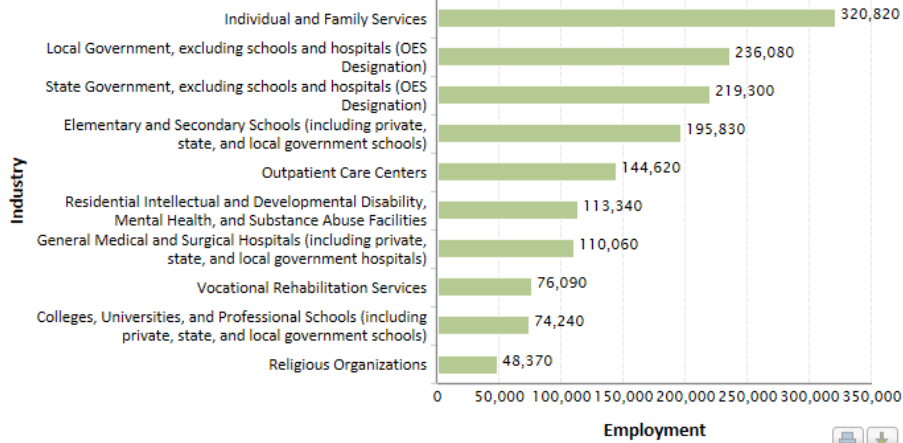

Industries with the highest employment level for Community Health Workers, May 2016



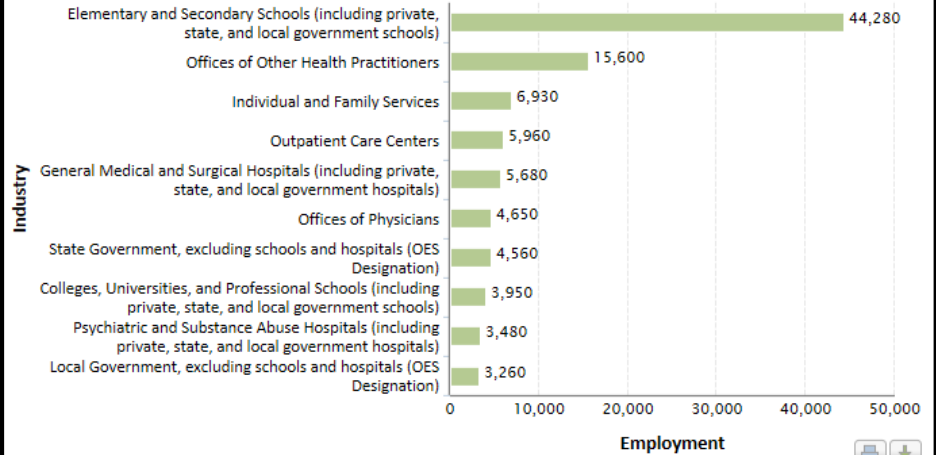

Industries with the highest employment level for Community and Social Service Occupations, May 2016

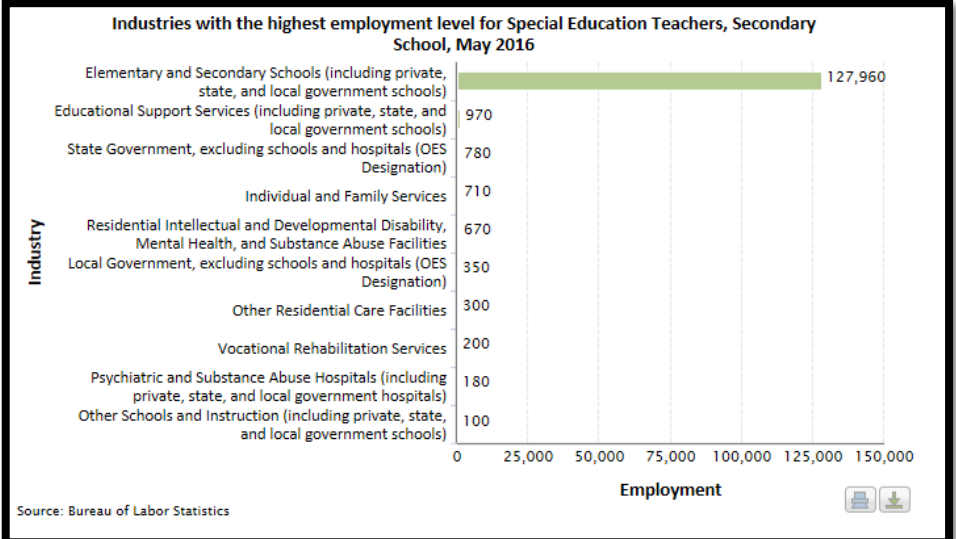
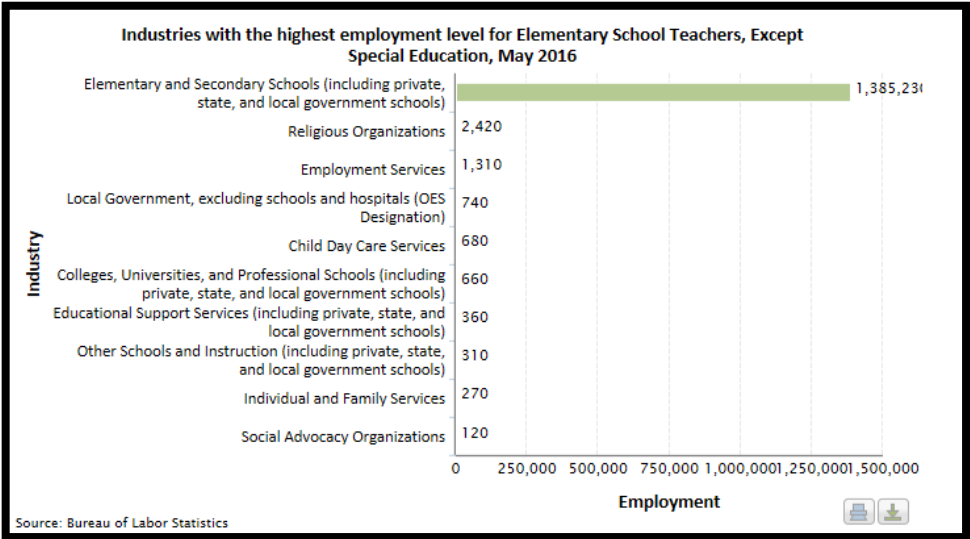
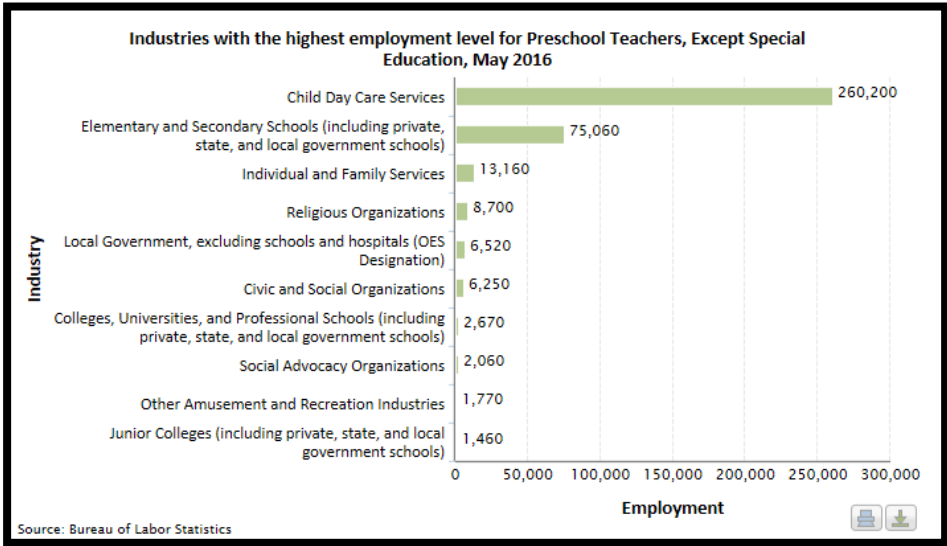
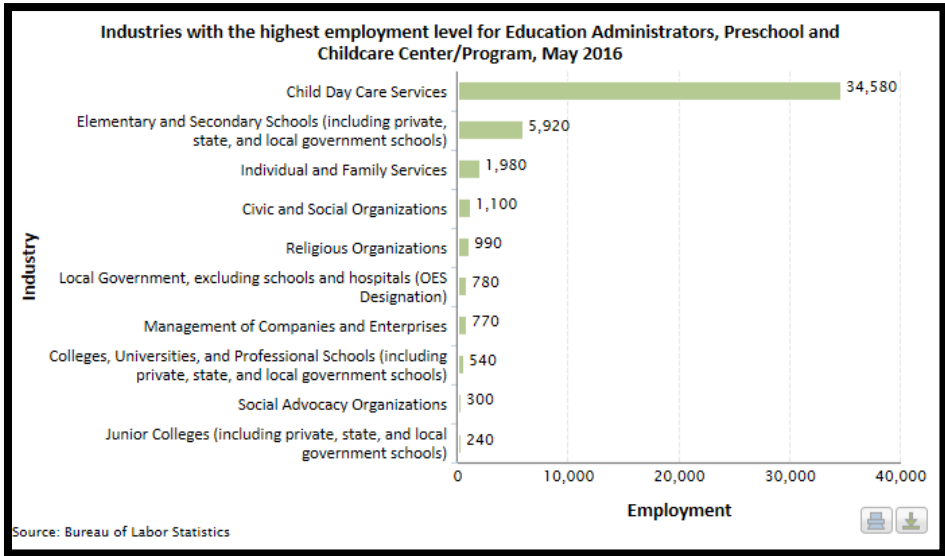


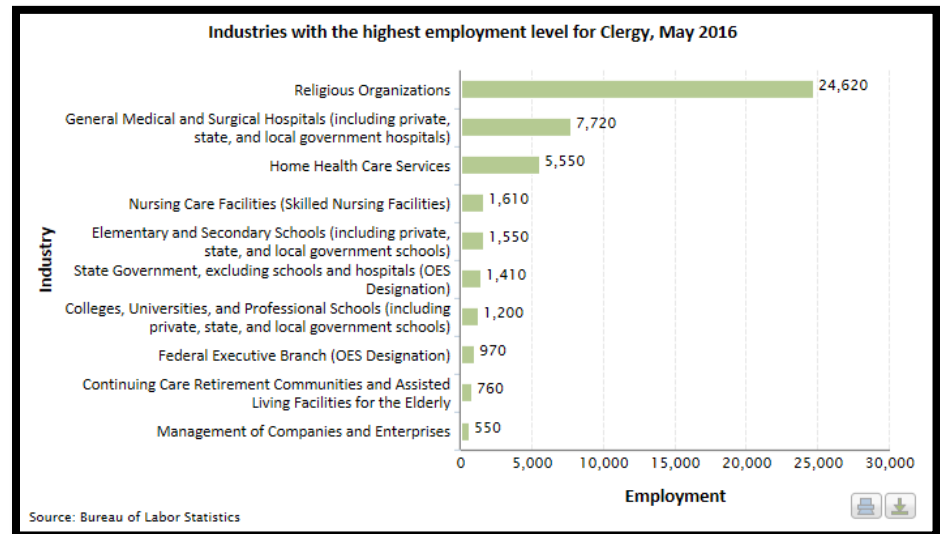
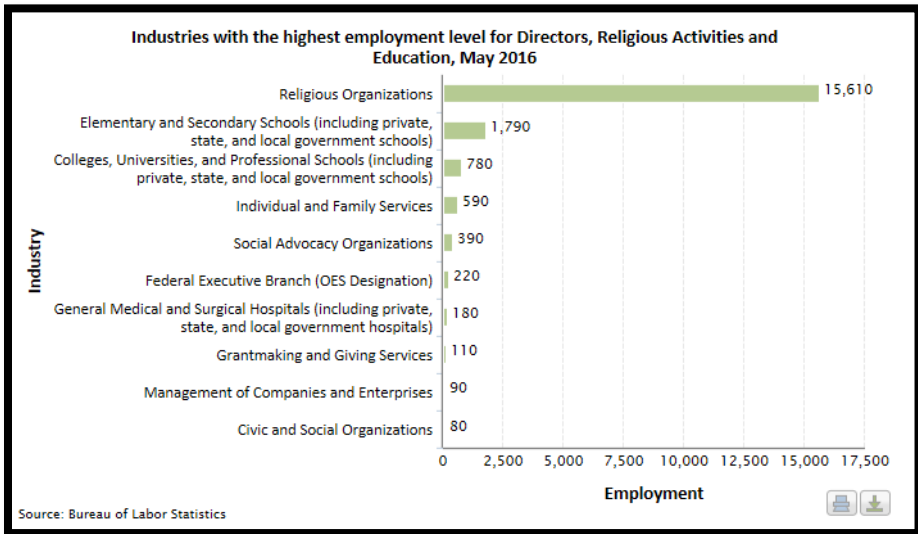
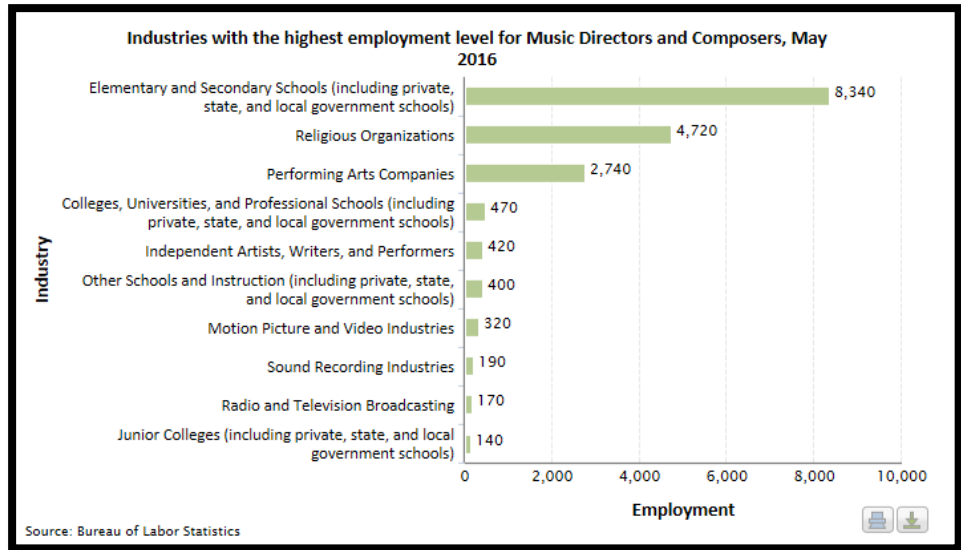
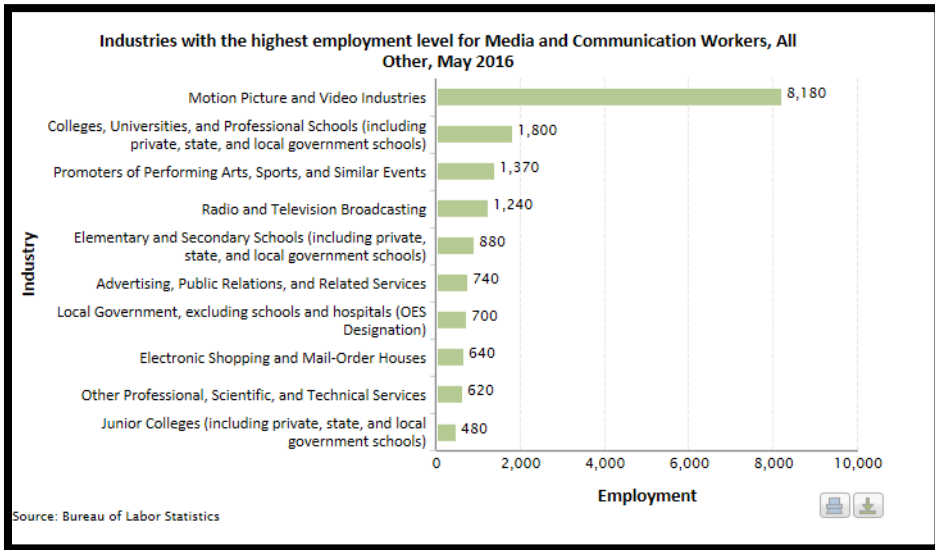
