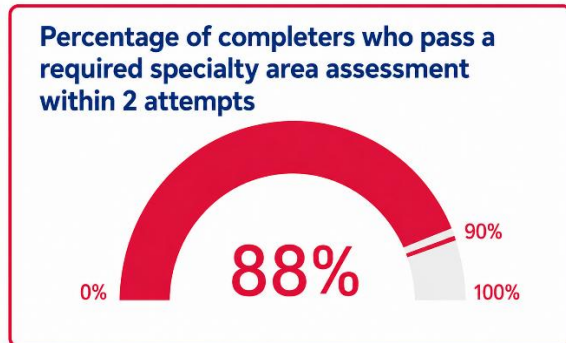


Templar School of Education Licensure Exam Statistics **2022-2025**

Specialty Area Assessment:

Threshold: 90% passing within 2 attempts

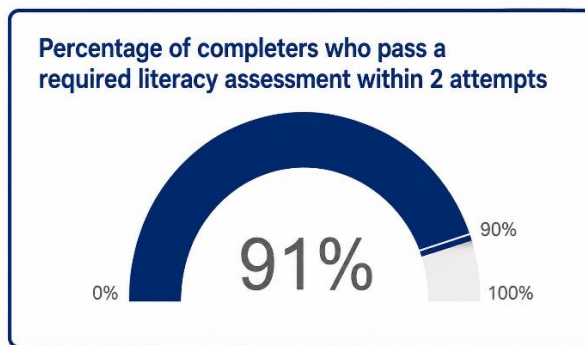
Goal: 90% passing within 2 attempts



State Literacy Assessment:

Threshold: 90% passing within 2 attempts

Goal: 90% passing within 2 attempts



The 90% threshold and goal align with Tennessee Department of Education expectations for the EPP Annual Report, which require 90% of candidates to pass the applicable assessment within two attempts to meet expectations. This performance expectation applies to both Specialty Area Assessments and the State Literacy Assessment.

In response to performance below the established threshold for Specialty Area Assessments, the Templar School of Education (TSoE) analyzed assessment data to identify areas in which candidates need additional support. Based on these findings, the TSoE purchased an assessment preparation and tutoring program that candidates use independently and within methods courses with faculty support.

Faculty also incorporate sample assessment questions early in designated courses to identify areas of need, familiarize candidates with assessment expectations, and inform targeted instruction and review. Candidates receive additional practice and support throughout the course based on identified needs.

The TSoE will continue to monitor first-attempt, within-two-attempt, and overall pass rates to evaluate the effectiveness of these strategies. Results will be reviewed through the continuous improvement process and used to determine whether supports should be sustained, expanded, or revised.
