CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP

PROCEDURES FOR APPLYING

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Complete any other documents required for packaging, if applicable.
- Complete a 500 word essay, double spaced on the subject: "How and Why I Have a Desire to Serve Christ in Youth or Children's Ministry." Include information about any personal involvement in Youth or Children's Ministry.
- Have a youth leader, advisor, high school teacher, college professor, minister or elder submit a letter describing your Christian character, performance, ministry experience, and potential as a successful Youth or Children's Minister. Be sure that the person explains the experience(s) upon which this information is based.

All paperwork must be turned in by the deadline to be considered for the scholarship.
