## CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- Open to any undergraduate student (incoming freshman - rising senior).
- Scholarship selection is based upon need and merit.
- Student must be planning on the pursuit of a career in worship ministry or in music education.

## PROCEDURES FOR APPLYING

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Complete any other documents required for packaging, if applicable.
- Incoming Freshman, Transfer and Change-of-Degree students must complete the online School of Communication and Creative Arts Application
- Incoming Freshman, Transfer and Change-of-Degree students must perform an SCCA on-campus audition for the Music and Worship faculty by May 1<sup>st</sup>
- All students must submit a resume highlighting activities in music, education, and worship ministry including but not limited to ministry in local churches (worship, music, youth), music ensemble participation, solo and group contests, chapel and campus events, teaching and mentoring opportunities, service learning and Christian service activities, community and missional outreach, Week of Evangelism activities, etc. Resume should include a purpose statement of why the applicant is pursuing a career in worship ministry or in music education.

**All paperwork must be turned in by the deadline to be considered for the scholarship.**
