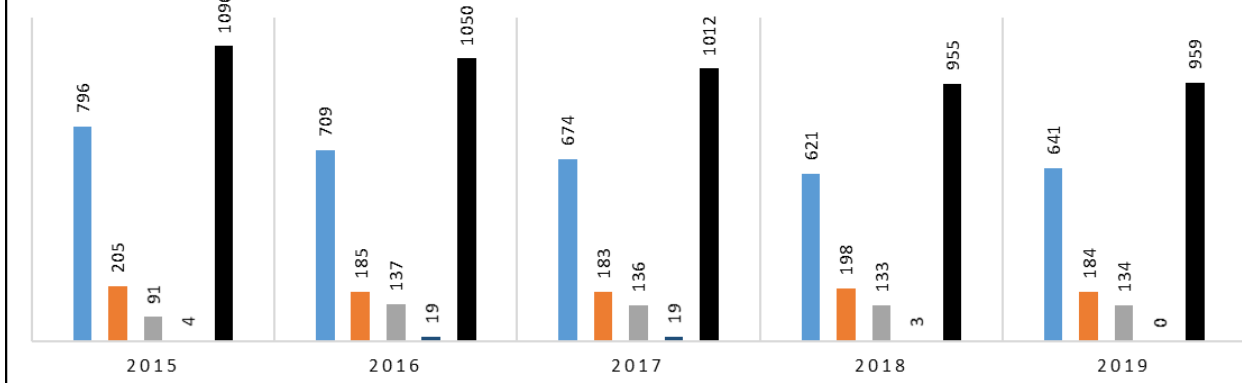
FALL ENROLLMENT BY DIVISION

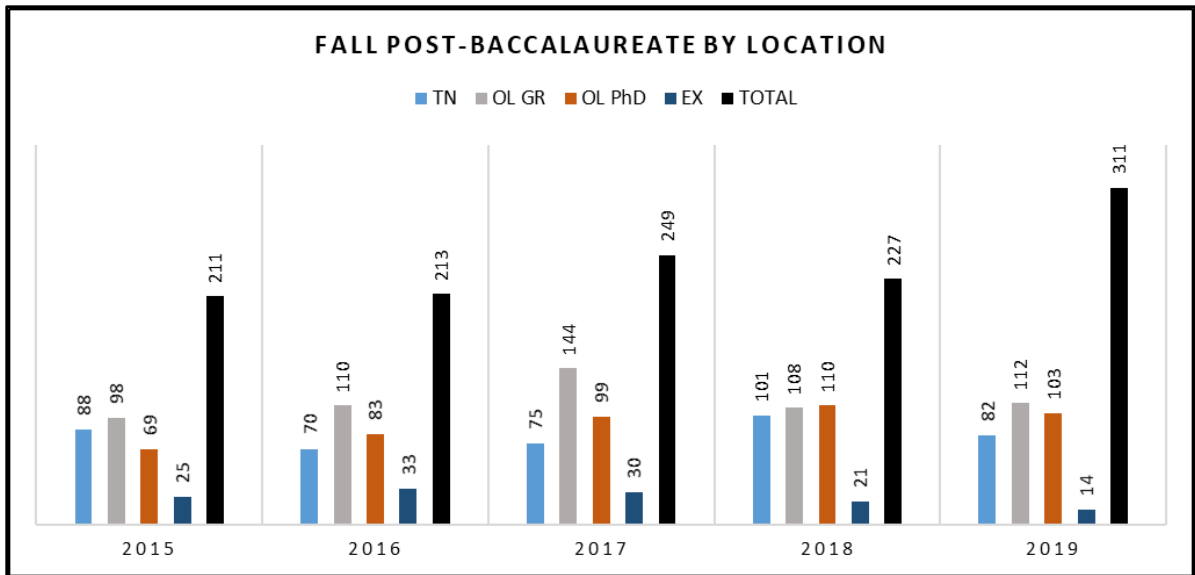

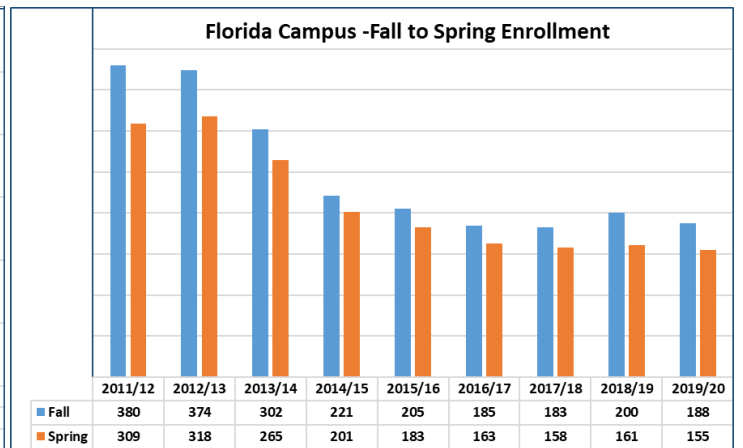
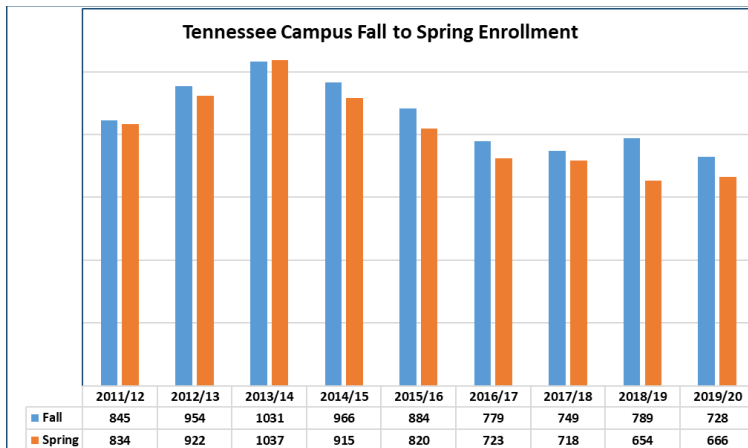
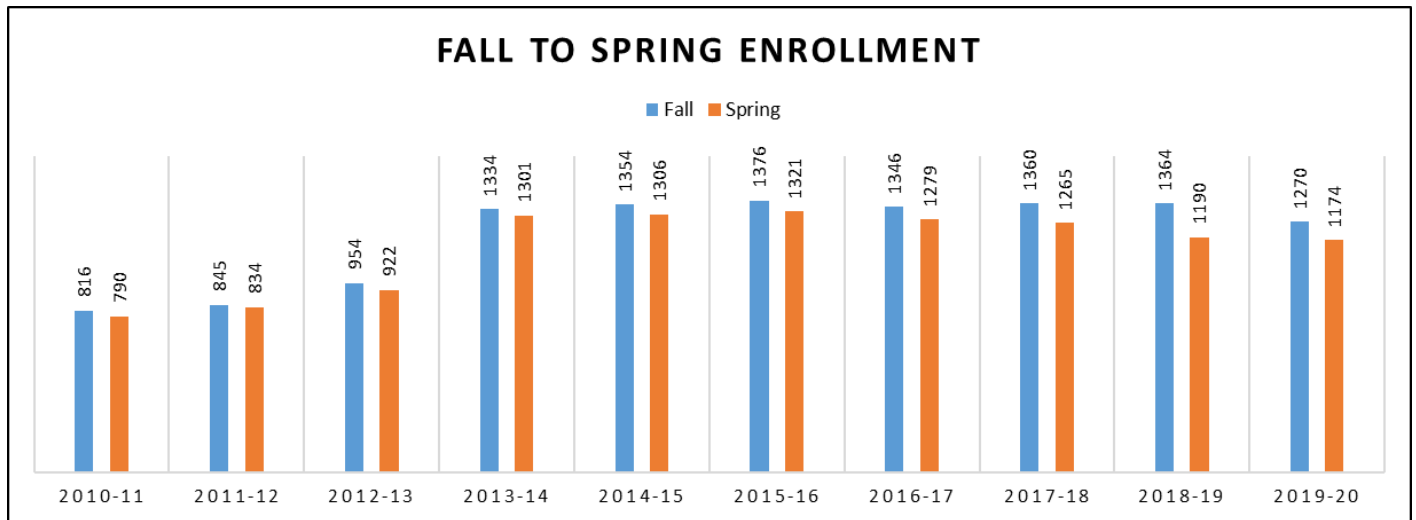
FALL UNDERGRADUATE BY LOCATION

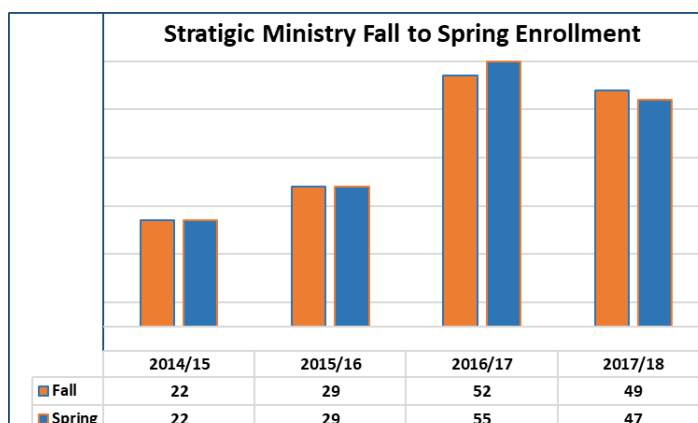
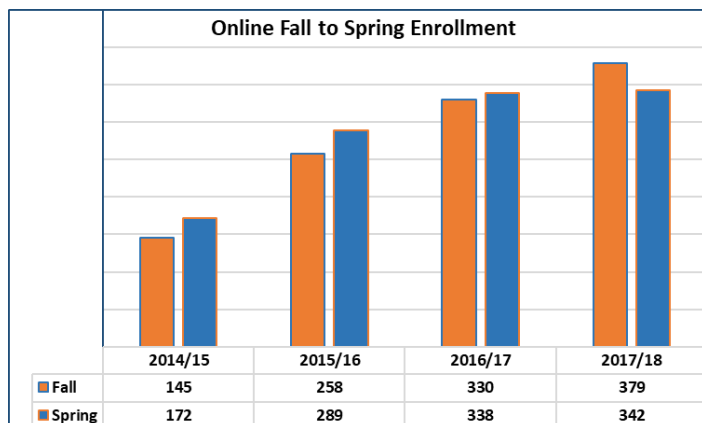
