



# SEPTEMBER

- <u>Request Information</u>

- □ Start your application (use code GO2JU to waive the application fee!)
- Ask teachers and other mentors for a reference letter
- $\hfill\square$  Start studying for the ACT, SAT, or CLT

# OCTOBER

- Plan a Preview Day Visit
- □ Take the ACT, SAT, or CLT
- Start collecting <u>scholarship</u>
  <u>applications</u> and check deadlines
- □ File the FAFSA (Open on October 1st)

#### NOVEMBER

- Complete and submit your admissions and scholarship applications. Be sure to keep a copy for yourself.
- □ Discuss college costs with your parents.

#### DECEMBER

□ Take the ACT, SAT, or CLT again



### JANUARY

Attend financial aid programs at your high school

# FEBRUARY

 Watch the mail for any information regarding financial aid or admissions

### MARCH

- Complete any remaining financial aid papers and scholarship forms
- □ Watch email for your Student Aid Report (SAR)
- □ Send the SAR to any of your chosen colleges if they haven't already received a copy
- □ Watch the mail for award letters
- Work with our Financial Aid Office to understand your aid and accept scholarships

#### APRIL

- Confirm enrollment at Johnson by paying the enrollment fee by May 1
- Sign and return award letters and any other required financial aid forms
- □ Register for Rising Suns

## MAY - AUGUST

- □ Take the AP exams (*if applicable*)
- Request that your final transcripts be sent to Johnson
- □ Attend Rising Suns Summer Orientation
- □ Work with Student Accounts to make arrangements and accept all aid
- □ Find a summer job
- Attend <u>Genesis Weekend</u> and get ready to be a Johnson Sun!
