Mission Statement

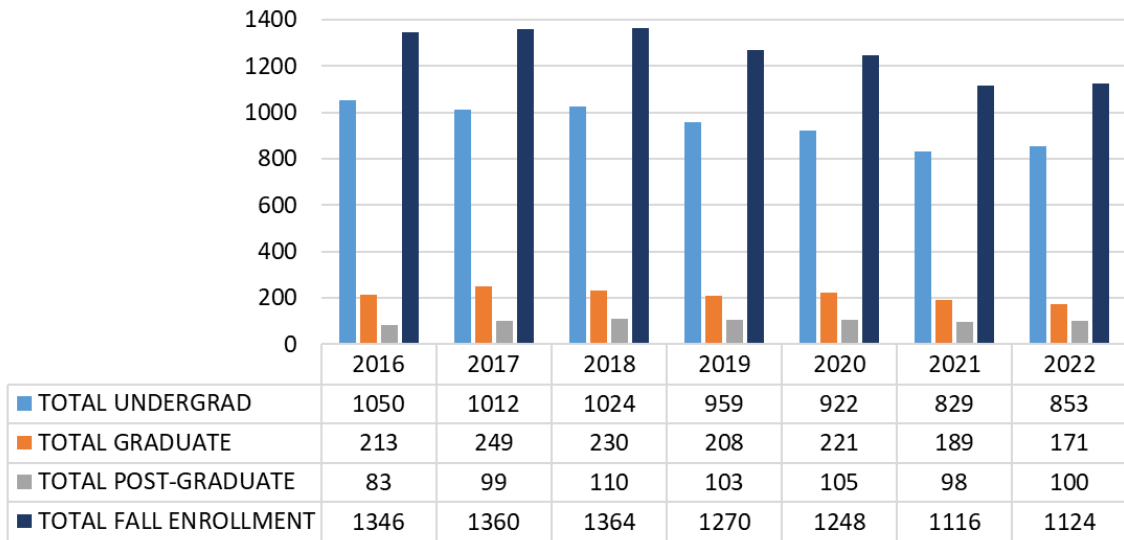

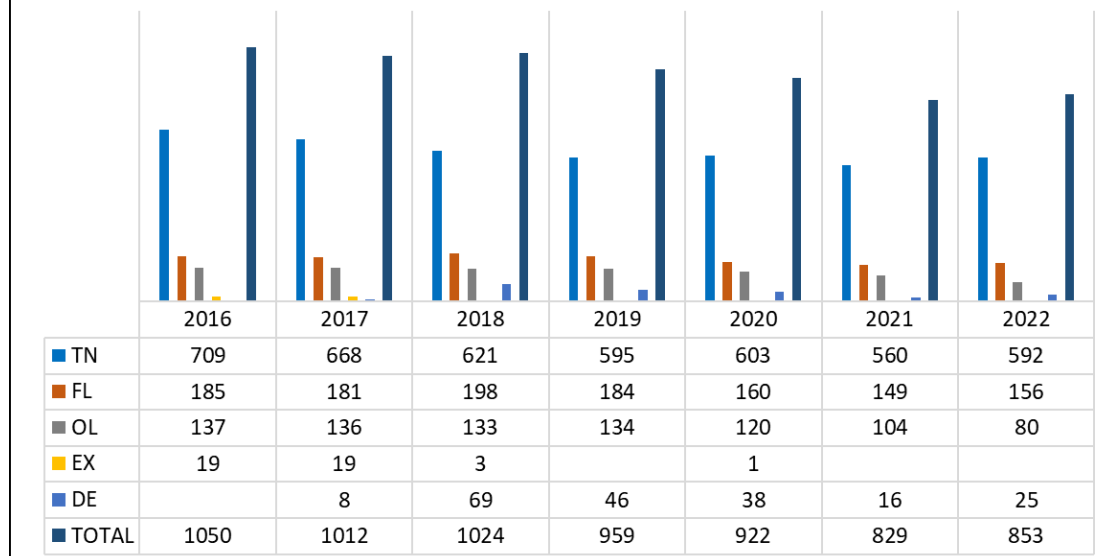

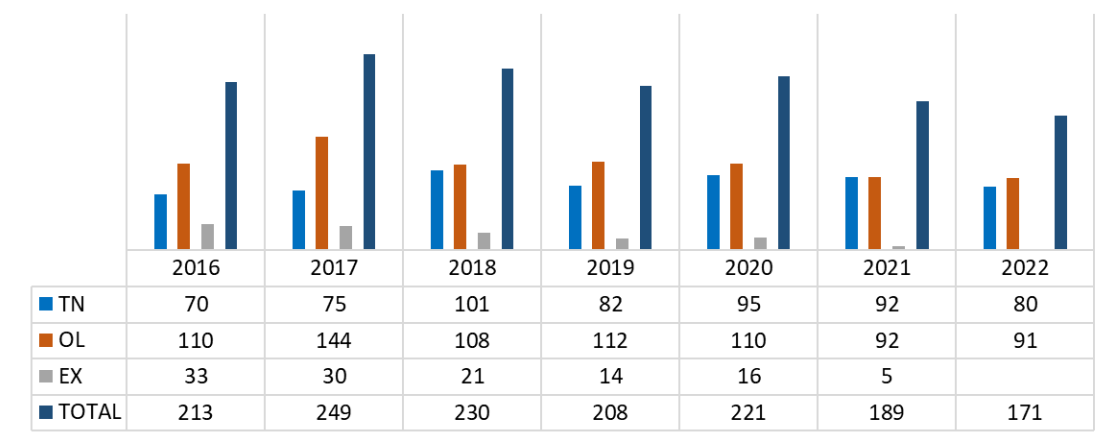
FALL ENROLLMENT BY DIVISION
